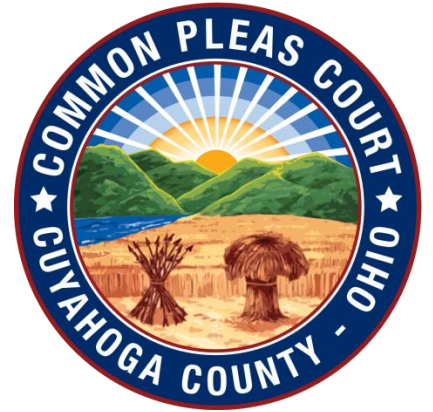

Court Hires Director of Training and Development
