

### Criminal Case Statistics


#### Newly Filed, Re-Activated and Transferred in Cases

The following chart is a representation of all filed cases in Cuyahoga County Court of Common Pleas from 2005 – October 2024. Newly filed cases are defined as having been arraigned and assigned to a Judge. Re-activated cases are defined as cases where a defendant was unavailable for trial and has now become ready to proceed. Transferred cases are defined as cases moved from one judge's docket to another. This could be due to re-assignment to a Mental Health Judge or after additional information indicates that by Court rule, the case should have been assigned to another Judge.




#### **Yearly Criminal Terminations**

The following chart represents cases that have been terminated by the court from 2005 – October 2024. These cases have been terminated either by trial; plea, dismissal or a defendant is unavailable for trial or sentencing.



#### Pending Criminal Cases End of Period

The following chart represents the total number of cases pending at the end of the reporting period from 2005 – October 2024. Pending criminal cases at the end of the period is determined by adding the total number of pending cases at the beginning of the reporting period, and all newly filed, reactivated and transferred in cases. The total number of cases terminated in the period is subtracted from the sum total pending at the beginning of the period to give the value pending at the end of the period.



#### Clearance Rate

The Clearance Rate is the total number of outgoing cases as a percentage of the number of incoming cases. Clearance rate measures whether the court is keeping up with its incoming caseload. If cases are not disposed in a timely manner, a backlog of cases awaiting disposition will grow. A Clearance Rate of 100% indicates that at least as many cases have been filed, reopened, or reactivated in a period have been disposed.



#### Arrest to Disposition Timeline

Arrest to disposition timeline is a method to measure how felony cases flow through the Cuyahoga County Criminal Justice System. By capturing how long a case takes to move from stage to stage, we can examine where problems may exist and where potential improvements in case processing can be made.

The source data was extracted from the Cuyahoga County Court of Common Pleas Case Management System. The overall population of sample data was based on cases terminated in a given month excluding cases that have gone through diversion programs. A case is defined as a defendant and all charges involved in a single incident. The period for the extracted data is from October 2024.

The stages examined were:

Arrest to Indictment
Indictment to Arraignment
Arraignment to 1st Pre-Trial
1st Pre-Trial to Plea/Trial
Plea/Trial to Termination


Due to the fact that each case may or may not have all of the stage date elements, a method to arrive at stage averages was applied. For a case to be included in the average for a stage there would need to be both dates for the given stage. A case would be included in the Arrest to Indictment stage if both arrest date and indictment date were available. This method was applied to each of the five stages. Next we calculated the total number of cases that met the date criteria for each of the ranges and also the total number of days between each date. To arrive at an average, the total number of days for each case in each range was calculated and divided by the total number of cases that met the date criteria. If a case had a time period or periods where the defendant was capiased or referred to the Psych Clinic, that amount of time was subtracted from the appropriate range. For re-indicted cases, the original arrest date is used.

The following three charts are for Jail, Non-Jail and combined Jail and Non-Jail cases. Jail and Non-Jail cases are defined by the posting of bond prior to plea or trial.


#### Average Arrest to Disposition Timeline (Jail Cases)




#### Average Arrest to Disposition Timeline (Non-Jail Cases)





#### Average Arrest to Disposition Timeline (Jail and Non-Jail Cases)



#### Yearly Average Arrest to Disposition Timeline












#### Bail Case Arraignment Activity


The following charts are reflective of arraignment activity where the defendant was not incarcerated at the time of arraignment. The source for this information was the Criminal Records Department.






#### **Overall Arraignment Statistics**











#### Judicial Foreclosure Clearance Rate Year 2024

The Clearance Rate is the number of outgoing cases as a percentage of the number of incoming cases. Clearance rate measures whether the court is keeping up with its incoming caseload. If cases are not disposed in a timely manner, a backlog of cases awaiting disposition will grow. A Clearance Rate of 100% indicates that at least as many cases as have been filed, reopened, or reactivated in a period have been disposed.






#### Avg. Number of Days to Disp. (Excl. Bank. Stays & Tax Lien & Tax Cert.)


The average number of days to disposition is the number of days from filing to a final disposition entry being filed with the Clerk of Court. The data sample is based on all judicial foreclosure cases terminated by decree or dismissal (cases terminated by bankruptcy are not included) in a month. Each case is examined to determine the number of days between filing and termination with the periods that a case may have been in bankruptcy subtracted. Adding the total days of all of the cases minus bankruptcy periods and dividing by the total number of cases calculates the average. In the following chart, tax judicial foreclosure cases are excluded.






#### Avg. Number of Days to Disp. (Excl. Bank. Stays & Incl. Tax Lien & Tax Cert.)

The average number of days to disposition is the number of days from filing to a final disposition entry being filed with the Clerk of Court. The data sample is based on all Judicial Foreclosure cases terminated by decree or dismissal (cases terminated by bankruptcy are not included) in a month. Each case is examined to determine the number of days between filing and termination with the periods that a case may have been in bankruptcy subtracted. Adding the total days of all of the cases minus bankruptcy periods and dividing by the total number of cases calculates the average. In the following chart, all types of Judicial Foreclosure cases are included.









- 1. Total New Judicial Foreclosure Filings from 2005 2024 by year


#### New Marsh of Lien/Quiet Title/Partition Case Filings for Years 2011 - 2024 YTD




#### New Marsh of Lien/Quiet Title/Partition Case Filings by month for 2024 YTD




#### New Tax Lien & Certificate Filings by Month for Year 2024 YTD



#### Magistrate's Monthly Reports

The Magistrates' Monthly Report consists of 5 reports. Below is a description of each.

#### Magistrate's Monthly Supplemental Journal Entry Report (R415)

Retrieves total number of supplemental entries and Decrees of Confirmation of Sheriff's sale created during a specific period. A supplemental entry is any journal created by a magistrate, which does not close out a case. For example, any magistrate's order (MG) setting a hearing, any journal entry (JE) ruling on a motion, journals confirming Sheriff's sales, etc.).

#### Magistrate's Full Disposition Count by Magistrate Report (R413)

Retrieves total number of cases disposed of during a specific period. The dispositions are grouped by Magistrate and then broken down by the type of disposition (i. e. Default, Dismissed with Prejudice, Dismissed without Prejudice, etc.) This report can be printed three different ways. Including tax cases (Full Dispositions), excluding tax cases (Non-Tax Dispositions), and Tax cases only (Tax Dispositions).

#### Magistrate's Monthly Cases Referred/Reinstated Report (R418)

Retrieves newly filed cases referred to the Magistrates Dept. and cases previously disposed by the Magistrates Dept. that are reinstated and re-referred to the magistrates. The cases are separated by Tax (filing code 1465; Tax Judicial Foreclosure & 1466; Tax Certificate Judicial Foreclosure) and Non-Tax (1460; Judicial Foreclosure Marsh. Of Lien, 1480; Partition, 1470; Quiet Title, misc. (i. e. 1391; Contract Other, etc.).

#### Magistrate's Monthly Hearing Totals Report (R3146)

Retrieves total number of hearings held during one month. The hearings are grouped by Magistrate and then broken down by what type hearing was held (i. e. Default, Pretrial, etc.).

#### Magistrate's Monthly Case Load Report (R3147)

Retrieves individual caseload totals for individual magistrates during a specific period. The cases are grouped by magistrate and then broken down by case type (i. e. tax judicial foreclosure, tax certificate judicial foreclosure and non-tax judicial foreclosure).

#### Magistrate's New Referrals/Assignments (R429)

Retrieves All cases referred to the Magistrate's Department. The cases are grouped by Magistrate and broken down into categories of CSPO (Filing Code 1491 Stalking Civil Protection Orders), Tax (1465; Tax Judicial Foreclosure & 1466; Tax Certificate Judicial Foreclosure), Non Tax (1460; Judicial Foreclosure Marsh. Of Lien, 1480; Partition, 1470; Quiet Title, misc. (i.e. 1391; Contract Other, etc.)).
