


Age of Active Pending Caseloads

For cases that have experienced a period of inactivity, the number of inactive days is removed from the age of the case. Additionally, cases that have been placed into programs such as diversion or treatment in lieu of conviction have been removed from the analysis. In the following chart, the total cumulative percentage may not always equal 100% due to rounding.


