

RESOLUTION WHETHER TO APPROVE THE PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS AND ESTIMATES OF COST FOR CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS AT THE JUSTICE CENTER COURTHOUSE COMPLEX

WHEREAS, Section 153.36 of the Ohio Revised Code states that, “If the plans, drawings, representations, bills of material, and specifications of work, and estimates of the cost thereof in detail and in the aggregate, required in sections 153.31 to 153.35, inclusive, of the Revised Code, relate to the building of a courthouse or jail, or an addition to or alteration, repair, or improvement thereof, [and] the estimated total cost of the project is greater than seventy-five thousand dollars, the materials also shall be submitted to the clerk of the court of common pleas, the sheriff, and probate judge, and one person to be appointed by the judge of the court of common pleas, for their approval.”




WHEREAS, plans, drawings, representations, bills of material, and specifications of work, and estimates of the cost (“Plans, Specifications and Cost Estimates”) were submitted to Cuyahoga County’s Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas, its Sheriff, its senior Probate Judge, and the appointee of Presiding and Administrative Judge of the Court of Common Pleas for their approval of the proposed projects known as (collectively, “Projects”) the following:

1. Tower II Roof Replacement Project,
2. Courthouse Sealant Replacement Project,
3. Garage Structural Repairs Project,
4. Elevator Modernization Project and Roof; and
5. Water Intrusion Improvement Project.

WHEREAS, the individual officers identified in R.C. 153.36 for Cuyahoga County have duly reviewed the Plans, Specifications and Cost Estimates for the Projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE INDIVIDUAL OFFICERS IDENTIFIED IN SECTION 153.36 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE FOR CUYAHOGA COUNTY that the Plans, Specifications and Cost Estimates for the Projects are approved by them as reflected herein, such approval being reflected in the written notation set forth in the grid below.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution was adopted in an open public assembly on June 15, 2026 and constitutes the minutes memorializing the proceedings before the individual officers identified in Section 153.36.
